This is my passion; awareness is my mission. Here is our story:

In November 2015, at seven years old, Regan became ill, throwing up, stomach pain, no appetite, and diarrhea. As his illness progressed, he developed a fever, rash, red-chapped lips, bloodshot eyes, and swollen hands. By day 11, he had been to the pediatrician twice, had two negative strep tests, given antibiotics, been to urgent care twice, had 2 blood draws, had hardly eaten in 9 days, had fevers above 105 degrees, and his hands and feet started to peel. As his mom, I was at the end of my rope.

On day 12, I started making a timeline of his symptoms. Physicians do not recommend this, but I had to do something. Every page presented Kawasaki Disease (KD). He had every symptom; it seemed so textbook, why couldn't his doctors diagnose this? Then the fear set in, it leads to heart disease and heart attacks in children...babies. I went to his room that night and laid my hand on his chest. I counted his heartbeats; I studied every inch of his body, kissed his forehead, and watched him breathe.

The next day I took him into the pediatrician's office knowing this appointment would be different, I was armed with information. They confirmed the diagnosis, examined Regan's heart, admitted us, and started receiving treatment. He continues to have lingering symptoms and will have his heart monitored for the rest of his life. We are so very blessed that to date, Regan's heart has not been affected. Many children are not as lucky.

KD awareness is critical for parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, teachers, caregivers, nurses, physicians... everyone. With the help of your sponsorship, we can fight back against KD.
